- -3 skeins Our tribe, Scheepjes
- -Hook 4,5,
- -Tapestry needle to weave in yarn tails

*Info:

- -The shawl consists of double crochet stitches and popcorns. The dc are crocheted between the dc of the previous row.
- -Ch 2 in the beginning of the right side doesn't count as a stitch.

US terms dc(s) - double crochet(s) ch - chain sc - single crochet pc(s)- popcorn(s) consists of 6 dc



*Instructions

- 1) Right side; magic ring ch 2 (does'nt count as a dc), 1 pc, ch 1, 1 pc, turn
- 2) Wrong side; ch 4, (counts as 1 dc + ch 1), 1 dc between the pcs, make in the back of the pc 1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc (photo), turn
- 3) ch 2, 1 pc in the ch1 space, ch 1, 1 pc in the next ch 1 space, ch 1, 1 dc between the next two dc, 1 pc in the ch 1 space (= the ch 4 previous row), turn
- 4) ch 4, 1 dc between the pc and the next dc, 1 dc between next dc and pc, between the pcs 1 dc, ch1, 1 dc, ch1, 1 dc, turn
- 5) ch 2,1 pc in the next ch 1 space, ch 1, 1 pc in the next ch 1 space, 2 dc , 1 pc in the ch 1 space, turn
- 6) Ch 4, 1 dc between pc and the next dc, 2 dc, between the pcs 1 dc, ch1, 1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc, turn. Repeat row 5 and 6. *Last row 1 pc, ch 1, 1 pc, sc between every dc, 1 pc
